1	Health and Safety Officer

2	War memorial	
	 (a) Still waiting to hear from Management of Brewery site re memorial on that site. There is a promise that Mr Jarvis will contact John-Gili Ross next week. Meanwhile Bowdens have been cooperating on the issue of repair to the Brewery Memorial. (b) Proposal for single memorial stone for village commemorating (but not naming) all who served during any conflicts since 1914. This committee agreed that any new memorial would best be sited on the green area near the village sign at the junction of Chapel Road with Colchester Road. Rosemary is investigating Stonemasons to assess design and cost. The size of the memorial should be appropriate to the site.
