





## Fordham 1, 2, 6, 7 & XX Maltings

Enablement of DSLAM (Fibre Cabinet)

#### **Current position**

- PCP provides copper broadband and voice Services
- Copper broadband availability is determined by distance from premise to Fordham Exchange

#### **Proposed Position**

 Fibre Broadband (FTTC) availability is determined by distance from premise to Fibre Cabinet (Opt in)







## Commercial -

- Confirmation of premises covered and formal Gap Fund Figure Provided (2 – 3 weeks) –
- Gap is 95,453 (no VAT) if not for profit Legal Entity
- £79.00 per Premise based on Equal Share
- Community Fibre Partnerships now use greater take up assumptions so would assume this is to be circa £50/60k -Areas need to be surveyed and final assumptions confirmed
- Private Funding mechanism in place and Community wants to fund
- Gap funded Model
- Payment terms 50% on Signature & 50% on Go live
- Provision of DSLAM (288 connections each cab)
- Contract agreement by July 2016
- Delivery by Summer 2017



#### Next Steps & Future environment

- Pricing is for infrastructure (Capex) only
- Speed upgrades and maintenance remain as part of BT Network at cost to Openreach only
- Future proof speed uplifts to be added at cost to Openreach only
