



West Bergholt Allotments

This summer we have experienced a very long dry period, which unfortunately has had an impact on crops, causing low yields. At the time of writing this, we have now had a few days of down-pours, however we need a lot more. Due to the dry conditions, it has been decided that there will be no bonfires for July and August on site. Please keep a check on notice boards for bonfires in September, October & November – these will depend on weather conditions.

Allotment rents will be due on 1st October 2018 – letters/invoices will be sent early September. We would appreciate early payment. If you have not received your invoice by 17th September, please contact the Parish Clerk or email wballotments@gmail.com.

Vacant plots – we still have some plots available. Rents for the year are very reasonable, ranging from £13 to £22 a year depending on size. Concessions apply for those over 60 on majority of plots. Preference will be given to West Bergholt residents, however individuals outside West Bergholt may also apply.

Charity Stall – Thank you for those that have donated items and given donations for those items. This year has seen a reduction in donated produce due to the dry hot weather, however thanks to those who help manage the stall, we still have a reasonable selection.

The new water tanks have now been installed - Thank you for those who helped with the installation of the tanks – they

West Bergholt Surgery

As the NHS celebrates its 70th birthday, the stresses it is increasingly under are being felt by the Creffield Medical Group who run the West Bergholt Surgery. Dr Hasan Chowhan from the group gave the following information to the Parish Council in July.

Since 2017 when the Creffield Medical Centre merged with the North Hill Medical Group, inherited issues have come to light, combined with changes in NHS funding and training. The numbers in the workforce have deteriorated due to retirement and moving, creating a dire situation with the number of available doctors reducing month on month.

There are issues with getting an appointment as there are not enough doctors across all the sites. There are two types of appointments:

- * Pre-booked appointments with specific doctors
- * Emergency appointments with those available.

The proposal was to run a pilot scheme between Nayland and West Bergholt:

- *Nayland would have the elective appointments, up to two weeks in advance with some slots for on the day, if possible.
- * West Bergholt would be an acute hub for urgent and emergency queries.

The reason behind this is practical:

- * West Bergholt's geographical position nearer to North Hill and central to the practice area.
- * The broadband is better, as Nayland only gets 2MBs which fails if more than four computers are online at the same time
- * There are more clinical rooms at West Bergholt in which to see patients.

It is in all our interests for the surgeries to survive, but until the Department of Health can find and train more doctors, things needs to be kept going as best as they can.

Although there is no direct bus service to Nayland, West Bergholt is very lucky to have an active Care Network. This volunteer-run organisation is aware that more people will need to be given lifts to Nayland; they now have 20+ volunteer drivers available.

Their details are below. If you have any other concerns on these changes to the surgery, please call the surgery direct on 01206 241137 or the Parish Council on 01206 240772 or email westbergholtpc@gmail.com.



The Care Network is available to anyone of any age who needs help getting to the local surgery, hospital or other appointment such as physiotherapy, chiropody, optician, osteopath, etc. It is also available to take people to visit others in hospital. We are monitoring developments at the local surgery and for the time being we are here to help with appointments which may not be in West Bergholt.

Telephone 0300 7773100 to speak to someone who will arrange the transport for you. Transport is only provided within the local area, but in exceptional cases a longer journey may be considered. The Care Network always needs more driver volunteers to enable the service to work efficiently. If you are able to offer an hour or two from time to time, as much or as little time as you are able, please contact Harry Stone on 01206 241026.

We will be present at the Village Fete on 1st September to publicise and answer any questions about this valuable village organisation.



Teenage Yoga in West Bergholt

I am delighted to tell you that over the last year I have been teaching yoga to children and teenagers in our village. Over a half term block, children are taught different yoga poses, breathing techniques, mindfulness meditations and visualizations, positive affirmations, yoga mudras, chanting... and so much more. I provide all equipment, you just need to turn up in comfy clothes with a bottle of water.

The children (and parents) have given me some great feedback over the last year. When asked for single words to describe the effect of sessions, I hear time and time again the same words, "calming, cleansing, stretching, relaxing, positive, strengthening, fun, calm, re-energising". Other comments include: "It helps me to settle better and sleep well at night"; "I feel more positive and strong about myself"; "My child is calmer and more rational after yoga".

It has been a huge success this year so, from September 11th, I am going to be running two sessions! These will take place at The John Lampon Hall (underfloor heating in winter!) on a Tuesday night for 5 weeks of each half term. The first session runs between 6pm and 6.45pm, and the second from 7pm to 7.45pm. The cost will be £30 for the half term block to be payable in advance to secure your child's place. It is open to all children (boys and girls) of secondary school age up to 16.

Yoga is not a "competitive pursuit" and I often ask the children to remember why they are there. This helps to keep their own focus on themselves. The children do not have to be particularly flexible to practice yoga, but it will help to increase flexibility, core strength, co-ordination and balance. I only ask that anyone who comes does so with an open mind and a willingness to learn.

It is my hope that children learn tools to help them lead positive, mental, physical and emotional lives with the power of yoga.

I have been practising yoga for over 12 years and I have been working with children for over 20 years. I also have two of my own children. I thoroughly enjoy my job and I'm passionate about making a difference in children's lives, especially with today's added pressures of social media, something which I didn't have to worry about in my own childhood.



Village Road Safety

The Road Safety Group was formed two years ago, prompted by a concern for safety around the Co-Op zebra crossing and the need to create a second road safety plan for school areas and other roads around the village.

The group is made up of Borough Council members, Parish Council members and volunteers from around the village. We are engaging fully with Essex Council, and Anne Brown, our County Councilor, has a significant interest in our campaign.

No single action will be able to remedy the problems we have in the village, as certain people will always think that they are above the law and will park in dangerous and illegal places. Therefore, at an early stage, the Road Safety Group decided to try and tackle the issues using 5 areas:

Engage the community
Encourage good driving and parking
Educate all sections of the community
Enforce the regulations
Engineer revised road layouts

What have we achieved so far?

Progress is slow but steady. So far some of the things we have accomplished/worked on are:

- Held a community workshop to engage with residents in the village to look at problem areas and solutions
- Adopted the free app try.gve to log poor parking. We now also have a process for reporting offending Commercial vehicles via this app. At one point, about 70 local residents were using this.
- Lobbied for increased attendance of the Borough Council parking patrol car
- We continue to push for a Special Constable to be recruited to help enforce parking law
- Designed and put up information banners at key areas in the village
- Engaged with school and local businesses
- Advertised at the Pharmacy about parking safely in the village
- Supporting a reduced speed proposal for roads into village
- We continue to review signage in the village
- We continue to patrol and to recruit parking monitors.

What are we hoping to achieve in the future?

The rules of delegation from North Essex Parking Partnership are being reviewed. If permitted, the Parish Council will be asked to consider the feasibility of engaging its own Warden. We will continue to work with the School, possibly through the School Council, to produce new banners and find innovative ways to encourage safe parking and driving. In September we will be at the Village Fete to introduce a Pledge Scheme to promote safe driving and parking.

Through our Borough Councillor we will continue to lobby the Local Highways Panel for reduced speed limits on the approach to and within the village.

If you care about making our roads safe and have a small amount of time available we need your help. Although outside help will remain a long term aim and we will lobby the Authorities heavily for support, competition for limited resources is fierce as all large villages in Essex have similar traffic problem.

You can help in the following ways:

- Set a good example by driving and parking responsibly
- Use the app safeland (formerly known as try.gve) and upload photos of badly parked vehicles to it you can be anonymous if you like
- Become a volunteer parking monitor to talk with drivers more formally and issue advisory notices, and if appropriate think of becoming a warden in the future.
- Join the group to refresh the ideas we have and take an active role in their implementation.

West Bergholt Local History Group

Our May visit was to the recently reopened museum in the Queens Hall, Chipping Hill, Halstead. A dozen members of the group attended and the weather was kind to us. The trip not only consisted of a guided tour of the Museum but a walking tour of the north part of the town.

The town has a long and varied history with evidence of human habitation since the early Bronze Age. Many examples of Roman, Viking and Saxon influence can also be found.

The Doomsday book recalls 3 watermills in the town and in 1251 Halstead was granted a Royal Charter to hold a weekly market and a summer fair. In more recent times an extensive silk weaving business was set up in the town by Courtaulds, who for many years was a major employer. The coming of the railway in 1860 bought more industry and prosperity to the town. One of the guides for our walking tour was Malcolm Root, a local resident and a well-known artist specialising in railway scenes. He showed us many interesting things, the site of an old workhouse, where the town's windmill stood and the cottage hospital opened in 1884 with help from the Courtauld family.

The Museum proved to be a treasure trove of Halstead archive and memorabilia, including Industrial, domestic and

agricultural items. As the Curator said, "We have just not got enough room to show everything!" It was a good day and we were made very welcome by the enthusiastic Museum team.
