

First Bus App

Did you know that the First Bus App can help check if your bus is on time or delayed? First Bus provides the 66 bus service to the village which runs from Rowhedge/Old Heath via Colchester Town Centre. Winter is approaching & using the App may help you avoid waiting in the cold.

The App helps you to:

- buy & use paper-free cheaper bus tickets with your phone,
- find bus times tap on a bus stop icon to get live* & scheduled times by picking the time & date of travel,
- access bus timetables & save your favourite bus stops,
- · check bus reliability.

(* nb – live times are shown where buses have tracking equipment installed & First Bus are continuously upgrading their buses so all can be tracked).

Most of the buses now accept contactless payments by card, so you won't need to find the right change.

Service Reliability

Parish Councillors told First Bus at Transport meetings about residents concerns on service reliability. The reality is that there will always be circumstances outside of their control resulting in cancellations. Councillors advised First Bus that the 66 route appears to suffer disproportionately and so requested that they spread the pain more fairly.

First Bus supplied information for the 66 bus that shows for the month of September, their busiest month, that 1 week out of 4 met their 95% target & they are internally looking to improve the service & its reliability.





Friends of St Mary's Old Church

We're pleased to report that work on the interior regarding decoration of the building will be in hand by the time you read this. This process marks the end of the major refurbishments that have taken place over the last three years and should see our venerable building made good for the long term. Whilst the internal works are in progress, the church will be closed to the public. It is hoped that the closure will not be for long but it may be protracted as restoration works will need time to dry out before the next stage is undertaken, so there will be times when not much is seen to be happening.

Notwithstanding the above, it is proposed that there will be a Mulled Wine and Mince Pies event at the Church on the 1st of December, when there will be an opportunity to see what's being done. In addition, the Annual Carol Service will take place on 15th December at 2.30pm. Space is always limited for this so early attendance is recommended.

Plans are being made for events next year, details of which will be published later. We also have some enquiries about weddings which we are always happy to support.

The popular Christmas Cards will again be available shortly, featuring seasonal views of the Church. We know that these cards are sent far and wide to folk who may well remember the building from time spent in the village.

Finally, our building like many others is vulnerable to those who would steal from it, particularly the lead from the roof. We would ask all those who regularly pass the building whilst exercising their dogs or themselves to keep an eye on the building and let us know if anything untoward or suspicious is happening. All authorised contractors will have vehicles bearing their names.

The Friends group is open to all who love the church and support the endeavours of the group to see it used and become a focal point in the community. A modest membership fee of £5 is charged which does not bring any benefits other than the knowledge that you are helping to keep the old place alive for generations to come.





West Bergholt Local History Group

Our winter programme of talks started in September when Jim Connor told us the sad story of the Wreck of the Cromer Express at Colchester's North Station in 1913. He illustrated his talk with a number of poignant pictures of the crew that unfortunately perished and the wreckage that resulted. In October, local historian Liz White told us some interesting stories about the Avenue of Remembrance and in particular some of the people recorded by the trees planted along each side. In November, Charlie Haylock delivered the third Bernard Colbron Lecture about the "History of Surnames" on his return to West Bergholt. Also, in October, a group of members visited Wivenhoe to hear how the Wivenhoe History Group researched and prepared their very successful "Stepping Back in Time" self-guided walk pamphlet and online material for many of the properties in the High Street.

The Impact of the Daniell Family on West Bergholt

Most residents will know that at one time there was a Brewery in this village which was set up in the 19th century by Thomas Daniell. 
Village Neighbourhood Plan Referendum

The Plan sets out where development might take place and what type of buildings will be acceptable.

It is important to emphasise how the adoption of the Neighbourhood Plan will protect our village from predatory speculative housing proposals in the future. Thanks are due to those who have tirelessly worked on the Plan over the years and to the villagers who turned out to register their support in the Referendum. West Bergholt is ahead of the game in this area and as a result of the support from our villagers we hopefully will continue to enjoy our village and not face it being changed in the future to the detriment of us all but for the profit of some.
