KEEPING YOU AND THE VOLUNTEERS SAFE

- Our priority is the wellbeing of you and the volunteers therefore
- All volunteers are resident in the village
- Direct contact will be avoided at all times so for example shopping will be left at your door and the volunteer will step back
- Washing of hands is paramount
- Avoid payment by cash. Try to use online payment services
- Online shopping may be a possibility
- Click and Collect is another option
- The local pharmacy can deliver prescriptions in the village

 The Allotments remain open to plot holders adhering to Government guidelines The landscape around the village is attractive and undulating for those wishing to walk, cycle or run The Parish is blessed with many footpaths regularly checked by the PC Footpaths Officer and always usable because of our stewardship and enabling circular walks Hillhouse Wood remains open and well managed by volunteers from Friends of Hillhouse Wood enabling this to be used for walking being within easy reach of the village The Lorkin Daniell Field and Poor's Land remain open for informal recreation such as walking, physical fitness training on an individual basis The MUGA has resumed for tennis in line with Government advice Social media platforms for keeping fit 	A large number of social media outlets are available free of charge to hold video chats with family and friends If you are unable to go outside for a walk where you can say hello to people you can phone the Care Network Helpline and arrange a friendly chat with a volunteer 0300 777 3100 The village Facebook page shows activity in the village so you can stay in touch Some of the streets in the village have created social WhatsApp groups to help bring neighbours together by checking on each other, distribution of information such as when slots become available for Click and Collect shopping, VE Day celebration & even a soft toy zoo in the street. Streets such as Mumford Rd, Albany Close and Valley Crescent have done this.
