The West Bergholt branch of WEA had to curtail their last course on "Imperial China: land and people" in spring 2021 because of the Covid-19 lockdown, but did manage to complete nine of the ten weeks of this excellently presented subject.

However, it may be the last course held here as this branch has been struggling with declining membership in recent years and with the additional loss of the Methodist Hall, it's in danger of folding.

The WEA West Bergholt branch was formed after a meeting of local people on Tuesday 20th October 1981, with the first topic in spring 1982 being "The citizen and the law; criminal, family and consumer" presented by local lawyers.

In the intervening years, subjects have included architecture, film, history, industry, literature, music poetry, climate, and many more and have been well supported, but now, with an aging membership, attendance has steadily reduced year by year and now the branch is not viable unless more people come forward to take on the running of it.

Anyone who would like to take on the task, it is not difficult and support is readily available from Debbie Young, the local Education Coordinator, as well as from WEA Headquarters in Cambridge. You can email Debbie at DYoung@wea.org.uk and she will offer all the help and guidance to secure the future of the branch.

It would be sad to see the demise of the West Bergholt WEA which has thrived for nearly forty years and has been a great asset to the village, offering not only a large range of subjects but also the chance for members to come, meet and socialise with likeminded people.


St Mary's Church

West Bergholt Concert Band



We plan to increase our membership, and in order to do this, we intend to hold a recruitment drive. We hope to encourage people to join us in our activities.



Since last year, there have been a number of changes to the committee running the WB Allotments, so I'd like to thank those who have now retired from the committee for all their hard work in the past.

The allotments are looking in great shape at present and we're hoping for a bumper year of crops. We're all certainly appreciative of the large water troughs installed fairly recently, which make watering a lot easier and quicker!

We've had a tidy-up round the site and, after having a last bonfire to clear any accumulated wood, we will not be having any more bonfires on site. The emphasis will be on composting as much as possible and taking any other material home for recycling.

The Charity Stall is due to reopen at the end of May with Covid restrictions in place, so please follow the usual hand sanitising before touching the produce. We'll also have a second collecting shed at the other end of the allotments for surplus produce and this will be brought down to the Charity Stall by volunteers daily. Scout Group Retirement

Some readers will have seen pieces previously posted on the West Bergholt Hub about Charles and Sue Hart "retiring" as members of the 1st West Bergholt Scout Group.

Charles "Baloo" Hart stepped down late in 2020 after thirty years of service to Scouting. Starting as a supporter and non-uniform member of the Group Executive (including a time as Chairman), Charles took on the role of Assistant Group Scout Leader in 2000 when there was a real risk of the group closing. In his twenty years as a uniformed leader, he moved from section to section, plugging gaps in leadership teams, assisting experienced leaders and helping new leaders. As well as providing support to adults, Charles provided good leadership to young people. If ever there was a leader who embodied his Jungle Book persona, it was Baloo! He also supported many of the group's activities within the village (such as church parades, gift services, village fetes, churchyard tidy-ups, etc). Charles always worked in the wider interests of the Group, taking a role in raising funds or assisting in maintaining the Scout Hut and grounds.

More recently, Sue "Mrs Baloo" Hart stepped down after an equally long period of service to Scouting. Sue has been one of the unsung heroes of the group, always in the background, doing the important tasks which enabled leaders to offer Scouting to young people. She has volunteered for some 30 years and has served the group in so many ways. Sue has been a non-uniformed committee member for most of her time and has even managed stints as Secretary and Chair. She will be best remembered as being the driving force behind the annual fund-raising jumble sale for many years.

Following their retirements, I'm delighted that The Scout Association has recognized their contributions by awarding each of them a Chief Scout's Commendation for Good Service. This award is only made to those volunteers who have delivered special service to Scouting and is very well deserved.

COULD YOU BE A VOLUNTEER POLICE OFFICER?

Are you over 18 years old and have 16 hours a month on your hands to volunteer as a Community Special Constable in West Bergholt?

You may have seen adverts for Special Constables initially in 2018 around West Bergholt, and in the last month on westbergholt.org.

Indeed, the last call for Special Constables was very successful with three Specials receiving their warrant cards in 2019 prior to their on-the-job training.

Unfortunately for West Bergholt one has been allocated to another parish, one liked the train so much they became a full-time officer and one has taken time off from training on maternity leave.

The Parish Council wish all three the best but now are looking for new volunteers.

Special Constables are volunteer police officers, holding the same office and powers as regular police officers. They wear the same uniform, carry the same equipment and are deployed to the same incidents.

Special Constables based in the community have their duty allowances and travel costs underwritten by the parish council.

The recruitment process is undertaken solely by Essex Police, including a fitness test, a test to check basic literacy and numeracy skills and an interview.

The whole recruitment and training process is confidential, the parish council receive anonymous monthly feedback on the progress of all recruits in Essex and do not know who they are until invited to the attestation ceremony (when they receive their warrant card) at police headquarters.

Hello everyone. It's so lovely to be able to update you on the last year. It's been a tough one but through hard work and the generosity of so many people, we're thrilled to be able to report that we had our second-best year. This was so needed because the applications from young cancer patients rocketed by 1332%.

The biggest problem for our young people was that they and their families were having to shield and couldn't work. For many, this meant they couldn't pay household bills, buy food and essential clothes. TBF assisted with these to help improve their quality of life.

For others, travelling to and from hospital has cost a fortune, as they've had to drive from home daily because they couldn't stay in hospital. TBF helped with these costs, reducing anxiety and worry.

Many of us have suffered social isolation and our teenagers have felt it too. They felt completely cut off from the outside world and were unable to access their schoolwork, support groups and friends. TBF purchased IT equipment to solve these problems and gave them a purpose to look to the future.

165 young people and their families were helped, and that is thanks to you, our wonderful supporters. Whatever we do, you're always there supporting our cause and we're so grateful. Scout Group

Like most aspects of our lives, Scouting has continued to be seriously affected by the pandemic and it is now thirteen months since we were last able to hold face-to-face meetings. In that time, we've offered some elements of Scouting to our young people but our inability to offer activities to everyone all of the time is a source of regret. In one sense, some have "lost" a year of Scouting experiences. Through Zoom, they've had quizzes, games, presentations, badge work sessions, scavenger hunts, cookery sessions, a theatre workshop, a magician, a village-based walking quiz, introductions to other faiths, singing coaches, escape rooms, virtual exercises in lieu of outdoor sessions and so much more.

Despite the disruption caused by the virus, our youngsters have continued with their badge work and I'm pleased to report the following successes: Chief Scout's Gold Award – Eden Clarke and Harry Leek; Chief Scout's Silver Award - Will Martin, Harry Patterson, Thomas Presland and Archie Welland; Chief Scout's Bronze Award - Archie Angel, Edward Spurgeon and Neil Taylor. There are more to come and some of our young people are staying on in their existing sections to complete their Award.

With the changes already made to COVID-19 restrictions, we plan to resume face-to-face Scouting soon. We're working on satisfying The Scout Association requirements, subject to our adult volunteers being happy to return. Plans for camps are still on hold.

In our annual membership return, we reported a year-on-year reduction in the number of young people in the group. The effect of not being able to hold face-to-face meetings was felt across all sections but especially in the sections that were unable to offer regular virtual meetings. Some parents have asked why we don't run more sessions and the answer is simple: we don't have enough adult volunteers. Our finances have been impacted by the disruption to Scouting but we had a fantastic response to a request for donations in lieu of subscriptions, with some 90% of parents responding.

In the last year, Charles Hart, Aron Newton, and Paul White have stepped down. Lee Crowdell will also be leaving soon. Together, these leaders have given over 50 years of service and we're so grateful for what they've done for our young people. Graham Ward has been awarded his Wood Badge on completion of his training and I hope to see more of our leaders being recognised soon.

We desperately need more adults to become leaders and members of the Executive, so please think about whether you can spare some time. We're already in a situation where we're restricting the number of young people who can get involved. If you need any information about volunteering with us, please contact me kevinsturdy@ aol.com.
