- Review site plan After January's inspections we have a few plots that needed reviewing for being untended. After the Late April inspection, letters will be sent to those plotholders not looking after their plots.

- 4. Funds available It was suggested by the Clerk we inform people we have funds for donation at the Annual Parish Meeting in the Orpen Hall. Emma mentioned that Bluebells were looking for a new climbing frame and that there was a girl needing donations towards modifying her home to make it accessible for her.
