from PC Meetings of May 2023

## Parish Council's Annual Meeting was held on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

Following an uncontested election on the 4<sup>th</sup> May, 10 out of 11 members took their places on the Parish Council. Cllr Brian Butcher was once again elected as Chair of the Parish Council for his second year in office. Much of the meeting was taken up with reviewing and ratifying WBPC's existing policies and Councillor roles as well as agreeing the 2022-23 AGAR form (Annual Governance and Accountability Return) prior to submission to the external auditor.

## Parish Council holds Extraordinary Meeting on 24<sup>th</sup> May 2023 in order to approve the more usual business of the council.

As much of the 10<sup>th</sup> May meeting was taken up with constitutional business following the four yearly elections, another meeting was held in the month to approve it's more normal business, such as payments and planning.

## Pothole Priority Repair List prepared for County Councillor Barber.

The list of priorities had been discussed earlier this month by the Environment Committee and the Clerk's Assistant was tasked with posting a reminder on the local Facebook Hub for residents to offer more suggestions of the worst potholes.

## Possible transfer of ownership to Parish Council

The Parish Council agreed to approach Colchester City Council in regard to ownership of the greensward on Mumford Close, at the back of 30 New Church Road.
