Uncle Kam's, Armoury Road potholes and zebra crossings discussed.

Residents' concerns in regard to the odours, litter and parking around the new Uncle Kam's fish & chip shop were raised with the City Councillors and it was confirmed Planning Enforcement has been contacted.

The potholes in Armoury were highlighted by City Cllr Willetts with the suggestion of the establishment of a Management Company to address the repairs – the Environment Committee will discuss at next meeting.

Work to the existing zebra crossing outside the Co Op and the proposed zebra crossing on Colchester Road were discussed.

Parish Council adopts Local Government Association's new Model Councillor Code of Conduct.

The new Code of Conduct came out in 2020 and has been adopted by Colchester City Council members from 1st Dec 2022. Although there are no sanctions linked to this Code, it goes into greater detail of how a Councillor should act and has been updated to reflect modern life and working practices. WBPC Councillors agree all in favour to formally adopt and adhere to this Code.
