NG Norwich to Tilbury consultation.

Cllr Short summarised the National Grid Pylon project, which will pass through West Bergholt parish. He had attended the recent public consultation event held in Langham and will be creating a response on behalf of the Parish Council. The Council continues to protest to the scheme both with the Planning Inspectorate and other interested parties, such as the Essex, Suffolk and Norfolk Pylons Action Group and Bernard Jenkin MP, preferring the undersea routeing. The consultation ends on the 21st August.

Parish Council applies for £10,000 from Essex CIF grant.

The Parish Council will be submitting an application for a £10,000 grant from Essex County Council towards the construction of the West Bergholt Community Hub, a small single storey extension to the John Lampon Hall at the Orpen Memorial Hall complex. Other grants have already been applied for to help fund this project and monies have also been set aside from the Hopkins Homes section 106 (development) monies.

Accessible toilet opens to public.

A new accessible toilet, with baby change facilities, is now open to the public at the Orpen Memorial Hall. The toilet, on the right-hand side of the building, facing the tennis courts, is open during daylight hours, and available for everyone using the playpark, Lorkin Daniell Field, tennis courts or just passing by. The toilet was funded by section 106 (development) monies and by the Enover Community Trust, through the landfill Communities Fund.
