from PC Meeting of Oct 2023

PC Chair sends letters to CCC and ECC.

Parish Council sends letters to Colchester City Council in regard to proposed NEEB construction access through Armoury Road and to question the City Council's investigations into the Uncle Kams fish & chip shop's breaches in planning. Letters were also sent to the CEO of Essex County Council on trying to re-establish Highways Devolution activities for the Village Handymen and on the slow progress of the proposed zebra crossing for Colchester Road.

Parish Council agrees to the provision of additional inclusive play equipment.

The Council agreed a quote for addition equipment including an inclusive swing, "me to you" swing, two sensory play items and fencing at one end of the Lorkin Daniell playground. The project will cost around £13,000, with £10,000 coming from the Hyperlocal grant, as well as from previous fundraising (including from the Village Quiz & Orpen Players productions). Many thanks go to the Orpen Players for their kind donations.

Multi Use Games Area WP re-established.

The MUGA Working Party was established previously to oversee the resurfacing. The group was recently reformed to agree a revised set of Terms of Reference and begin work on managing & improving use of the tennis courts. The Working Party is looking to expand its membership and will report back to the PC at a future meeting. Please contact the Clerk, on details below, if you are interested in joining.
