Commemorative D-Day flags.

The Council approved a resolution to purchase 2 commemorative D-Day flags for June, one of which will be donated to Heathlands School. The Parish Council (PC) flag will be hoisted onto a new wall mounted flagpole holder at the front of the Orpen Hall, the previous flagpole having been destroyed by Storm Eunice.

Internal Audit finds no issues.

The internal audit of the Parish Council's 2023-24 accounts took place on the 18th April, with no issues found. The AGAR (Annual Governance & Accountability Return) internal audit sheet has now been signed by the auditor and will be submitted to the external auditor, PKF Littlejohn, once Sections 1 and 2 are signed at the upcoming May PC meeting.

Quote to move JL Hall fire escape doors agreed

A quote was approved at the meeting for the demolition and moving of the JL Hall fire escape doors at Orpen Memorial Hall in readiness of the Parish Council's WB Community Hub project. The double doors to the tennis courts side of the Hall are to be demolished and filled in ready for the Hub to be added to the JL Hall. The new doors will be fitted at the back of the hall, to the field side, continuing to allow emergency access from the building if needed. Work is hoped to begin in the May half term so as not to disturb Bluebell's Pre-school during term time.
