from PC Meeting of June 2024

10-year agreement approved with WBFC

At a recent meeting between WBPC with the Football Club, several items were discussed including weed spraying of the LD Field, the transfer of the defibrillator to the PC for positioning on the Orpen Hall and an update to the WBPC/WBFC agreement. The revised agreement had been circulated to members of the council in advance of the meeting, having been updated by Cllrs Short & Butcher then agreed with the football team representatives. The agreement had been extended to 10 years from 8, so that the club could seek grant funding from the Football Association and was approved unanimously by the council.

Cycling Working Party

Terms of Reference agreed.

The Parish Council has set up a Cycling Working Group to determine the need for cycle facilities/additional facilities in West Bergholt. Its remit also includes promoting cycling routes, including off-road, and investigating the reinstatement of village-to-village cycle rides/rides to places of attraction.

With two successful meetings under their belt and members with a variety of cycling experience, the terms of reference were approved by the Parish Council so they could continue to make progress.

Drop-in Café Taster Session

Feedback from Cllr Stone.

Cllrs Stone & Cullis ran the taster session of the new Drop-In Café, with parent volunteers, a representative of the YMCA and 9 young people in attendance. The YMCA representative came up with some very good tips on running the café and they have assembled a good team of volunteers to move towards the 18th of Sept as the first regular session. There will be a meeting soon to discuss arrangements for September when it is envisioned that there will be a professional youth worker present, 3 volunteers and a maximum of 30 young people.
