Dear All,

Firstly, I do hope by the time you read this the WB Community Hub is open for use. If not it will be very close to being finished! I thought I would just take this opportunity, as the works are so near to completion, to let you know where the monies to build the hub came from. Indeed you will see a plaque on the building when opened to say where the funding has come from, as well as one about the time capsule!

The monies have been split nearly equally from Grants (Rural England Prosperity Fund, ECC Community Initiative Fund and the ECC Love Essex Fund), from dedicated CCC agreed Section 106 monies (funding from five local developments), and from the Parish Council reserves (built up over the years) all being spent for the long-term benefit of the community.

Secondly, a brief note on April's Annual Parish Meeting for those of you that were unable to attend.

This year's speakers were headed by Mayor Councillor Lesley Scott-Boutell, (attended by the Mayoress her daughter Miss Jessica Scott -Boutell), Heathlands new Headteacher Darryl Crawley, and Essex Association of Local Council Chair Mike Eldred.



Lesley spoke passionately about her year as Mayor, the City, her experiences and charities, Darryl spoke on his role as headteacher and his education experience and Mike on the work West Bergholt Parish Council has undertaken to be awarded the Gold Award under Local Council Award

Scheme, which only 50 out of 10,000 town and parish councils in England have ever achieved!



West Bergholt's Volunteer of the Year was announced as Liam Rix, a young volunteer and trampoline star from Bounceabilty whose commendation was glowing. A truly inspirational young man and an utter benefit to our community.



The evening was then rounded off with '3 minutes of fame' for 1st WB Scouts, WB Cricket Club, Bergholt Heath Youth FC, WB Girl Guides & Brownies, Women's Institute, WB Indoor Bowls, Bergholt Youth Group, the Care Network and West Bergholt Gardener's Association, all of whom spoke glowingly about their achievements, their members and their clubs' futures.

New Appointment System

As you may or may not be aware, the Surgery has undergone a change in how patients can now book appointments. NHS England have steered the focus of General Practice in the direction of Digital Health. Digital Health in simple terms means increased access via digital avenues to access healthcare. This does not mean healthcare is exclusively delivered digitally, nor does it mean access for those who do not use the digital platforms is limited. It simply allows those who can submit requests digitally can do so from their home, workplace, during school run etc. Those who cannot access the surgery are still able to call via our phone lines and we anticipate waiting times on our phones will decrease significantly.

How GP request an appointment

Simply log onto the Creffield Medical Group Website, click on the Contact Us tile on the front page (RED TILE) and complete the relevant form (either Admin enquiry or medical enquiry). Please ensure you do not add a medical query to the admin form as this may not be dealt with within timescales required. Please include as much information as possible as this will help us to manage your request or query efficiently for you. If you telephone us, we will complete the form on your behalf. You can also click onto your NHS app to complete and submit the request form.

What happens next

Once your medical enquiry has been submitted one of our Lead GP partners will view your request and mark the urgency and correct Practitioner suitable for the medical appointment, we will then send an appointment via text or phone call. This system will allow the urgency of patients medical needs be the forefront rather than the old system of "first come first served". For administrative queries, these will go direct to our admin team.

How long will it take

We will process your request or query within 2 working days, dependent on clinical urgency. If you need to see a clinician in an absolute emergency, please visit the Urgent Treatment Centre within the grounds of Colchester General Hospital. However, we are delighted to advise that most medical enquires are processed in one day.

Feedback

This process has been in place since 3rd March 2025 and we have had some very positive feedback from our patients.


